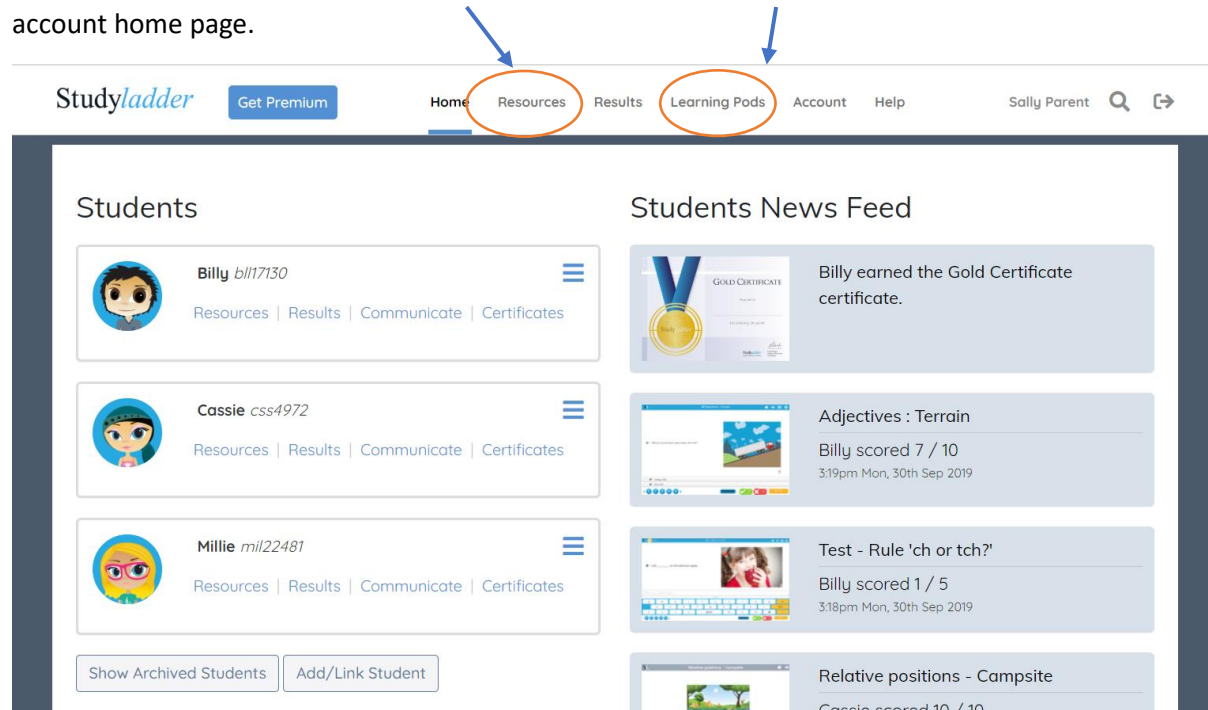


How to set activities for your child – Home Plus subscribers only

You can set activities for your child via 'Resources' or via the 'Learning Pods' tab on your parent account home page.



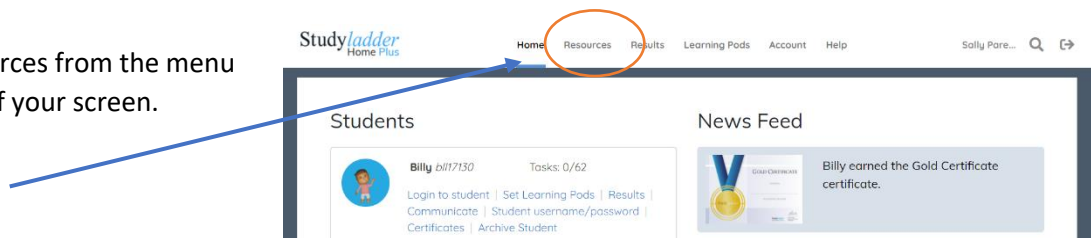
1. Set activities via Resources / Quick links

An easy way to set activities is via quick links.

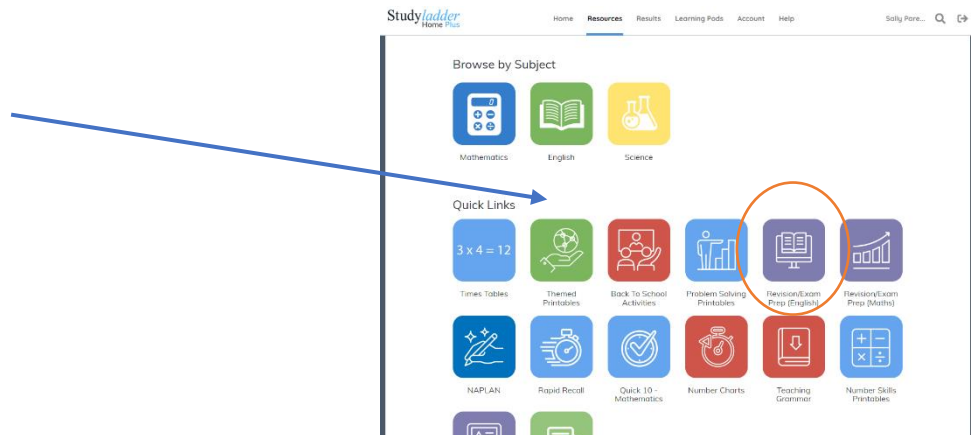
Many of our Home Plus activities are set up as quick links to assist you to access them quickly.

Additionally, many of our free access materials are set up in quick links for our Home Plus subscribers to make selecting just the right group of activities for your child so much easier.

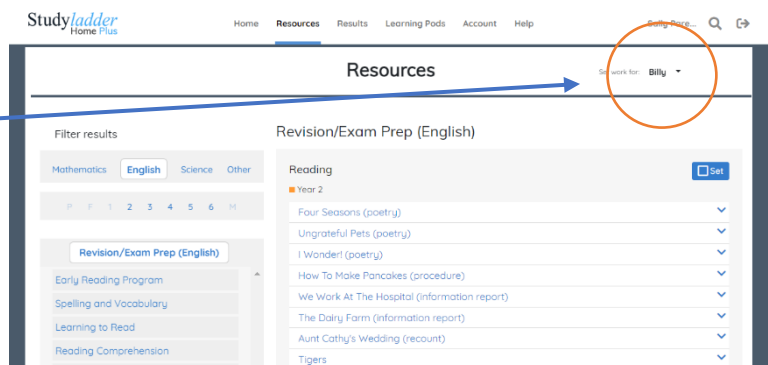
Select Resources from the menu on the **top** of your screen.



Select a Subject or a Quick Link area you want to assign to your child (in this example we will select Revision Exam Prep (English)).

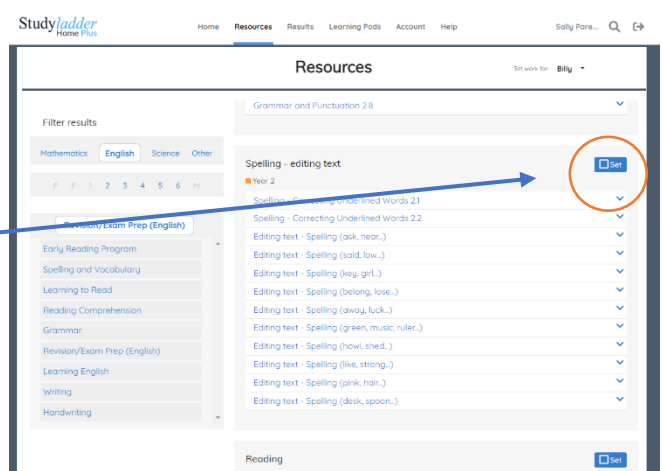


Select the student account to which you want to assign activities.



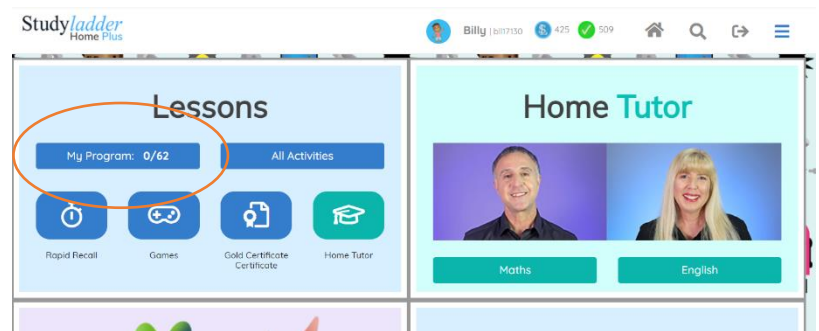
Then scroll down the page to search for the activities you want to set.

Once you have found what you want, click the blue 'set' box.



You can find multiple activities to assign to your child. Once 'set' they will appear on their student account.

The activities will appear in the child's student account, under the 'My Program' area.



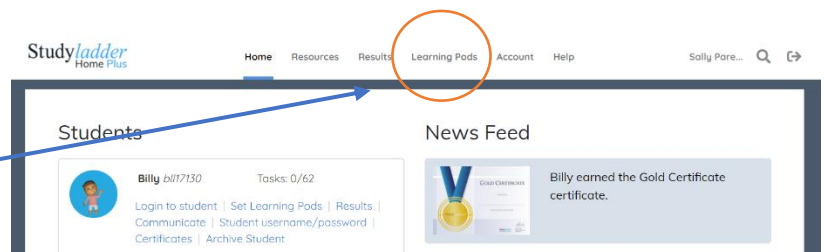
2. Set activities via Learning Pods

A Learning Pod is a folder where you can store a group of selected activities and then assign them to a child. You can create your own pods or use the Studyladder created pods.

The learning pod option may be useful if you home school your children and want to re-use a set of activities.

Teachers use Learning Pods so they can re-use each year if they continue with the same grade level class.

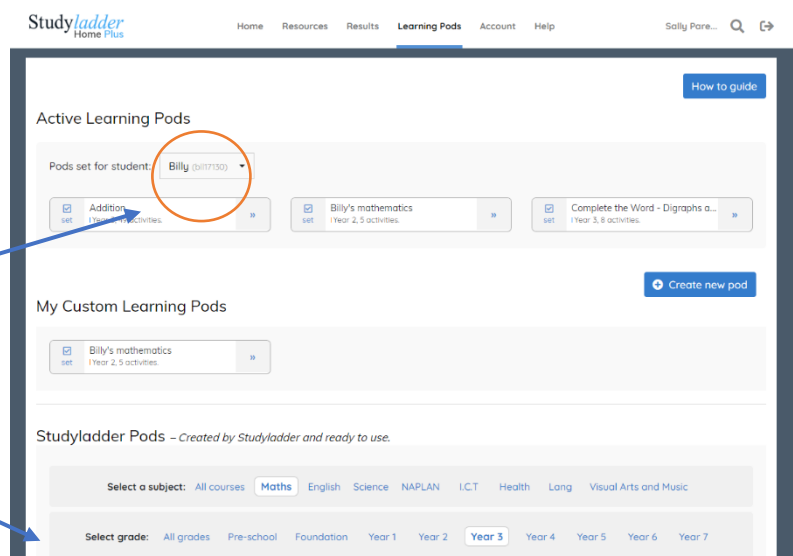
To access Learning Pods, select the Learning Pods tab from the top menu.



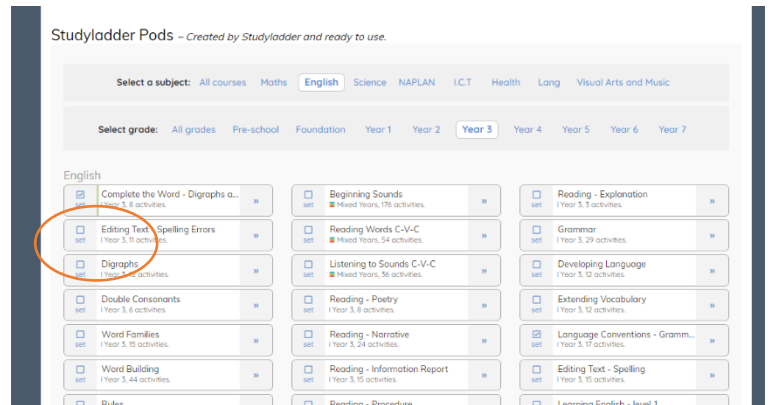
To set Learning Pods created by Studyladder

Select the child to whom you want to assign a learning pod.

Select the subject and then grade to refine your search.



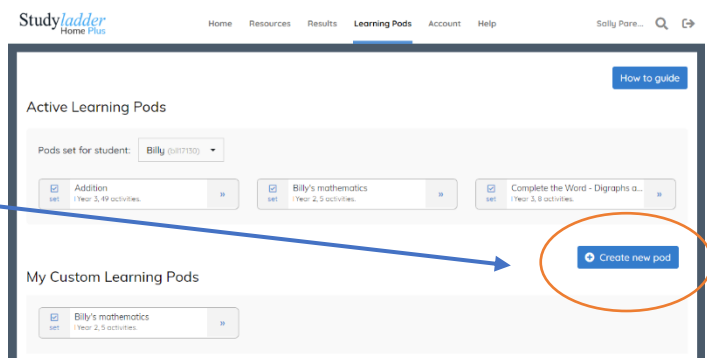
Search for Learning pods you want to use and once you have found the learning pod you want, select the 'set' box and the activities within this pod will appear on the child's student account, in the 'My Program' section.



To create your own Learning Pods

On the Learning Pods page:

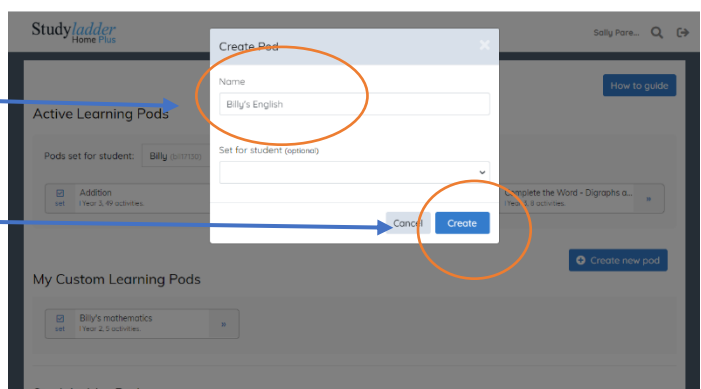
Select the blue button '+ create new pod'.



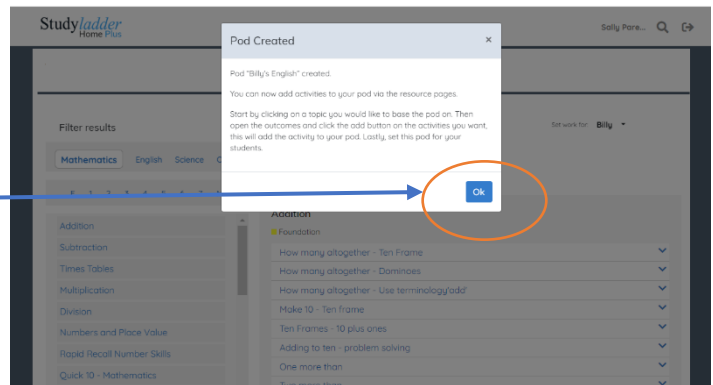
Give your pod a name.

Note: you do not need to select a student

Then select 'create'.

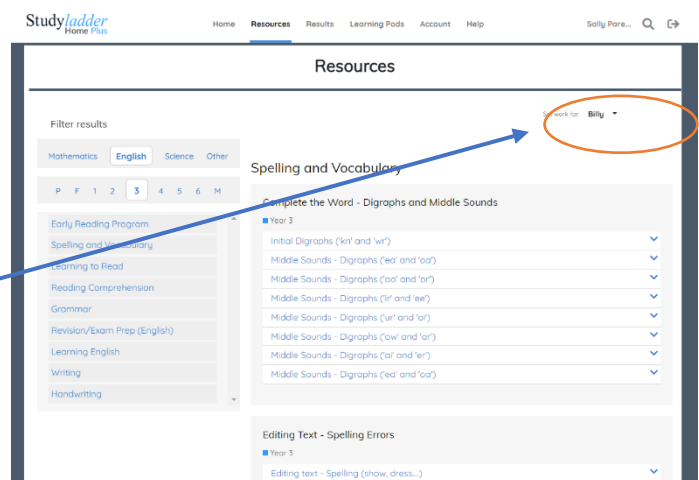


Select 'ok'



Now you are within the pod, you can filter through the resources to find what you want to add.

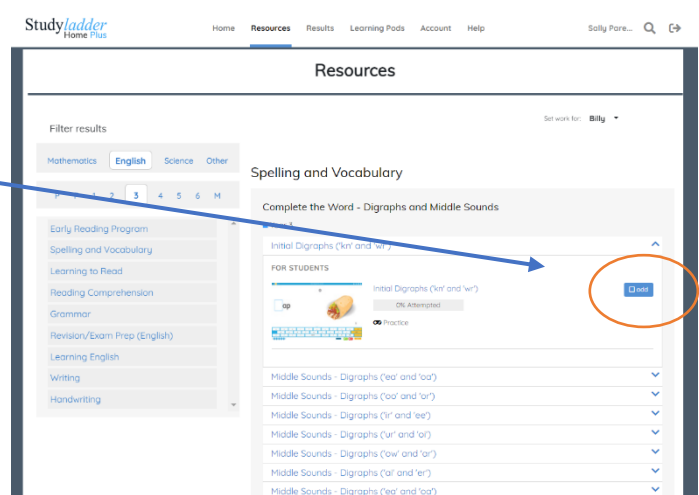
You can also choose who you want to set work for from the drop down menu.



When you find activities you want to include, select the blue 'add' button.

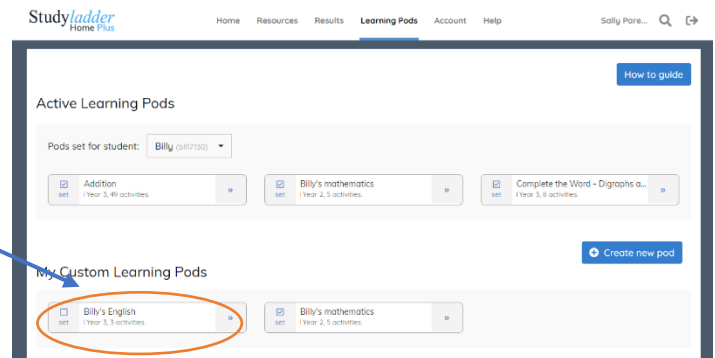
The activity will be added to the pod.

Exit by selecting Learning Pods on the top menu

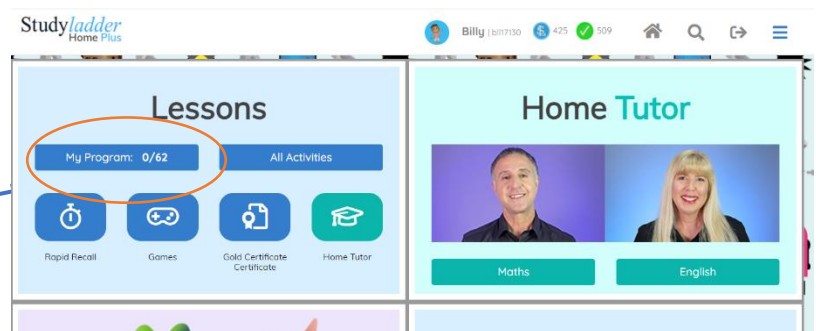


The pod will now appear in your 'My Custom Learning Pods' area.

Select 'set' and it will become an Active Learning Pod



The work that you have set will appear on the child's student account, in the 'My Program' section.

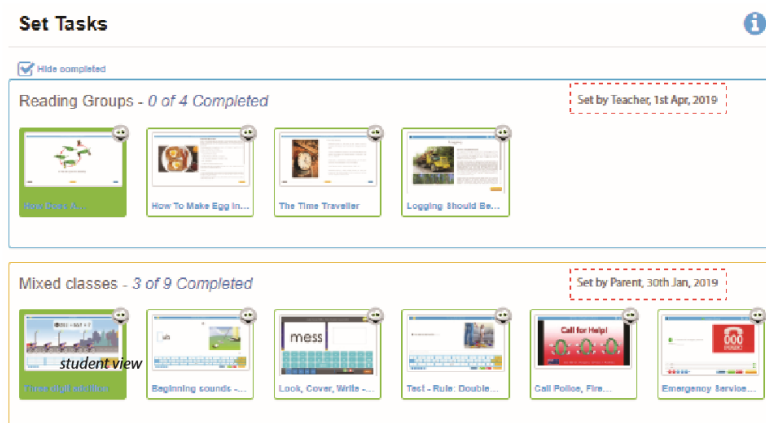


This pod will remain until you delete it. You can edit it to add or remove activities. And you can re-use the pod for another child at another time.

What happens if a child's teacher also sets activities?

Teachers and Home Plus parents can set activities for their students/children at the same time.

One section with activities set by the teacher and another with those set by their parent.



A teacher will not see activities set by the parent, however they will be able to see the results of completed activities
